Students who visit museums in kindergarten are shown to have higher achievement scores in reading, mathematics, and science in third grade than children who did not. The State Museum provides free programming to children and families most at risk for deficits in academic achievement.

- \$1 per pay period (x 26 paychecks = \$26) provides an elementary class with hands-on workshop programs at the State Museum.
- \$10 per pay period (x 26 paychecks = \$260) supplements school bus stipends for low income districts.
- \$20 per pay period (x 26 paychecks = \$520) provides an early learning family engagement workshop for 20 Trenton community members.
